<u>President – Mark Spease</u>

The County association meeting will be in August. Mark reports we had a meeting with Turf & Tundra and Rolling Hills on June 28th. Sixteen people attended. They talked about the club's history, the number of miles groomed, and equipment each club has. This was a brainstorming session and Tara has a full report of the meeting. They spoke about fundraising

ideas. Mark pointed out that the ATV club get more money per mile than the snowmobile club. They spoke about why other clubs joined ATV and Snow club together, but that is off the table at this point for our club. Mark indicated he will be working with the County's reps on why there is such a discrepancy in per mile funding between snow and ATV/UTV.

Mark read a thank you note to the club from the Webb Lake Community Club for their help and loan of tables for the spring sale.

<u>Vice President – Randy Shimanski</u>

The website information is in the process of being worked on. Check the website for misinformation and changes needed. Randy sent Mark the list of duties of the directors (version #1). He is looking for feedback. Randy had a sheet for review and comment. Deb Grobner will send Randy financial information from last year for a basis for the budget. Randy is working on a rough budget with categories of income and expenses for more clarity.

Treasurer-Deb Grobner

Deb provided a financial update.

<u>Social Events/Fundraiser – Terri Guertin</u>

Terri was not present--First Meat Bingo was held at the Cabaret on Friday, June 31. Total cleared after expenses was \$319. There are more scheduled for July 14th, 28th, August 11th and 26th. They will need four people to volunteer for each event. There was conversation regarding increasing the price of the cards to \$2 each and also substituting money for meat. As the event continues, we will see if changes are needed.

Membership – Brian O'Toole

Brian O'Toole was not present, but the indication is that most membership is online now. We had questions regarding what the duties of the membership leader are. Randy S. indicated he would be willing to volunteer to do the report for members. We spoke about pricing of membership (family, individual) and # of votes (i.e. currently family membership only gets one vote). We also discussed different levels of sponsorship (Gold, Silver, Bronze) based on size of ads/donation of money to club. Michele Lacy approached Mark after the meeting and is interested in taking over the Membership role. Mark will be connecting Brian and Michele to discuss the duties, time requirements and Brian has agreed to fully train her. Michele will decide after talking with Brian.

Equipment Maintenance-Terry Quinlan

Mark reports we still need to get chains off one tractor. He thanked Duane for mowing at the shop.

Trail Maintenance – Dave Nelson

Dave Nelson indicated he is starting with signage after September 16th. Mark indicated we are able to start cutting limbs after July 16 (DNR guidelines). We will organize groups of trail cleaners as a number of sites need work. Watch FB or for texts of maintenance opportunities. If volunteer brushing on your own, report to Dave Nelson or Mark Spease what trail was worked on, what work was done, for how long and what equipment was used so we can submit reports to the County for reimbursement. It all adds up!

<u>Grooming Report – Duane Staehnke</u>
